

## Preparing for your Presentation

1. The duration provided for the presentation of your Idea and illustrations is 15minutes (12 min presentation followed by 3 minutes of Q&A). Please design your slides to fit the time frame and practice to make sure you will not run out of time.
2. Each illustration should not be crowded by text and graphics. Contextual illustrations should support the presentation; Graphics used for communications should be more understandable, and point out the basic ideas.
3. Presentation should be clearly structured. Begin with a title slide ---Outline of the presentation. Background and previous work should be summarized to provide a prospective for the results presented in the paper. The innovative approach should be clearly stated in problem and objectives should be clearly defined,
4. The application area of the work must be pointing out with main features, characteristics, and the problems with solutions.
5. The results should be clearly outlined and evaluated. Appropriate comparison with previous results should be presented.
6. Conclusions should summarize the work performed and point out the main innovation and results. Future work and developments could also be sketched.
7. Try to fit your presentation in Maximum of 10-15 slides

Each session room will be set with an LCD projector, a microphone, a laptop/desktop and a laser pointer. **Please upload your presentation materials on EDAS before November 15, 2018.** It is recommended to test the presentation materials, e.g. video and audio, in advance of the session to ensure compatibility. Each room will have a Session Coordinator and a Student Volunteer that can help to provide technical support.

Presenters are requested to be present in the room at least 20 minutes before the start of your session and introduce yourself to student coordinator. Sign the register to show that you have presented your paper.
